Embossing and Stamping Dies

BASIC SHAPES FOR EMBOSSING AND DEBOSSING

The shapes die-makers use in producing the three types of embossing dies are shown below. They are single level, multilevel (flat levels) and sculptural (contoured, textured, realistic, etc.). Any combination of these profiles can be used in a single die.

The edges of levels can have a beveled edge, which is a straight angle to the paper plane (other than perpendicular), or a round, or chiseled, or curved edge. See numbers 1 through 4 on the illustration below.
